The Educational Interpreter salary structure recognizes differences in education and whether the employee has successfully completed the Educational Interpreter Proficiency Assessment (EIPA).

Grade levels for Educational Interpreters are determined as follows:

Grade

- 60 Language Facilitators
- 62 Educational Interpreters with high school diploma who have passed EIPA.
- 64 Educational Interpreters with an associate's degree in Educational Interpreting from an accredited program who have passed EIPA.
- 65 Educational Interpreters with a bachelor's degree in Educational Interpreting from an accredited program who have passed EIPA.
