What: CHAMPs: Proactive and Positive Approach to Classroom Management (1.8 CEU's)

Content: CHAMPs covers the components that the effective teacher research indicates as critical for a positive and effective classroom environment. Structuring the classroom, setting expectations, developing effective rules and class-wide expectations, using effective encouragement procedures, consequences (teacher actions to misbehaviors), and how to effectively correct are a few of the topics covered. Participants will be taught a plan to use with unmotivated students who may be experiencing behavioral problems. An overall classroom management plan will also be taught.
