

Adding Student Sites:

In SchoolCenter, a teacher can create a website for his/her students off the teacher's website. This could be used for students to share documents or information with their teacher, learn how to create a website, or post a blog. Be sure and check privacy settings to allow or not allow public access or to password protect the pages for student security.

Creating a Website for the Student

- 1- Choose EDIT
- 2- Choose ADD A PAGE
- 3- Choose Class Projects
- 4- You can give the title Class Projects a different name by typing it in the Page Title Section under the General Tab
- 5- Choose EDIT and ADD NEW SITE
- 6- Choose Edit Default Pages and Settings so the Page Links that are on each student page are the same
- 7- This will create a NEW SITE for a student

Creating User Access for the Student

- 1- Click on the USER Admin Tab from the student homepage and set the student up as a user of their page
- 2- Choose ADD USER
- 3- Choose NEW USER and Next
- 4- Type in the User ID (such as JasonSlate)
- 5- Fill in the information under the User Info Tab
- 6- Choose the Access Info Tab and choose to make the user a "RED" User (Student User)
- 7- Choose Done
- 8- Give the User Editing Privileges
- 9- Choose Done
