Credit card payments will be accepted online at www.k12paymentcenter.com; copy or screenshot your receipt. Checks are not accepted. Completed vehicle information cards must be signed by the student and parent/guardian and submitted with payment or receipt. CTE student drivers do not have to purchase an additional Weaver parking permit; however, they must display the parking permit from their home school AND complete the vehicle information card.

<u>Weaver Intervention and Study Event</u> (WISE Lunch and WISE PM) – WISE Lunch is assigned to students who have missing assignments, need to complete test corrections or retest, need remediation and/or tutoring, etc. Students serve either with a specific teacher or in Room #204 with Ms. Holt on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. WISE PM takes place in the Media Center on Thursdays from 4:20-5:15pm and is supervised by Mrs. Allison and Ms. Sturdivant. WISE PM may be used to make up time for unexcused tardies.

PVA student drivers must purchase a Weaver parking permit. Permits are \$50 and must be purchased each school year. Cash only will be accepted in the Main Office (Level 2). Credit card payments will be accepted online at www.k12paymentcenter.com; copy or screenshot your receipt. Checks are not accepted. Completed vehicle information cards must be signed by the student and parent/guardian and submitted with payment or receipt. CTE student drivers do not have to purchase an additional Weaver parking permit; however, they must display the parking permit from their home school AND complete the vehicle information card.

Students who complete Driver Education behind-the-wheel training must have a Driving Eligibility Certificate (DEC) from Weaver Academy to present to the N.C. Department of Motor Vehicles when applying for a Learner's Permit. The DEC is valid for 30 days and requires a parent signature. Once a NCDMV appointment is made, call Mrs. Jones in the Counseling Office for an appointment to get the Driving Eligibility Certificate.
