SCHOOL

NWHS is a comprehensive four-year public high school. Students typically take six periods, which are ~55 minutes long and meet five days a week. To graduate, students must meet the state of NC graduation requirements and local course requirements. The school is in a rural/suburban community consisting of five areas, which include Summerfield, Oak Ridge, Greensboro, Colfax, and Stokesdale.

Our students have access to over 80 clubs/activities. The 2023 graduating class had a 98.8% graduation rate and earned approximately \$10.5 million in scholarships.

CLASS RANK

The grade point average is computed at the end of each year and includes all subjects in which a student receives a letter grade. It is determined on a four-point weighted system, with grades for Honors and Advanced Placement/Dual-Enrollment courses assigned one-half and one additional quality point respectively. Cumulative weighted class rank is provided on a student's transcript.
