## Title I Parent and Family Engagement (PFE) Requirements 2021-2022

## Our Plan to meet ESSA Requirements:

- ANNUAL MEETING: Will be conducted in conjunction with our Open House event and virtual Town Hall meeting.
- FLEXIBLE MEETINGS: All school events will be offered at different times throughout the day in an effort to
  accommodate family schedules. Parent-teacher conferences will be scheduled 1st and 3rd Quarter at a time
  that works best for the family. Events and conferences will also be offered virtually to allow families the
  opportunity to participate on-line.
- INVOLVE PARENTS IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF PFE PLAN AND THE TITLE I PROGRAM: Parents on the School Improvement Team will have the opportunity to provide input. All other families will have the opportunity to view the draft that will be posted on our website and provide feedback.
- PROVIDE INFORMATION TO PARENTS: Important information will be shared via weekly Monday folders, school newsletters, Class Dojo, Sunday phone calls from the Principal and school social media sites. We encourage all families to stay connected.
- ALLOW FOR COMMENTS ON PLAN: During Spring 2021, families will have the opportunity to view
  the draft that will be posted on our website and provide feedback on the draft. Feedback will then be
  considered and the plan updated to the greatest extent possible.
