As you prepare for the 2020-2021 school year, we want you to have some important information about what to expect.

Meet and Greet Times

As I mentioned in my parent message to you recently, please anticipate a phone call from your child's teacher this week welcoming your child to Rankin and informing you of their new class assignment. Teachers will also host a virtual "Meet and Greet" with parents for you to receive important beginning of the year information and resources. Please make sure that we have your correct contact information and e-mail address. There will be a "Kindergarten Drive Thru" on August 18th from 9:00 to 10:30 a.m. and 5:00 to 6:30 p.m. as we welcome our new Rankin Rams with a special hello!

Based on public health guidance, the first nine weeks of school will be delivered remotely. Within the week, you will receive more details about:

- your student orientation date and time
- student assessments
- health and safety protocols
- remote learning expectations

Below you will find additional information regarding remote learning:

The First Three Weeks of Remote Learning in Guilford County Schools/Rankin:

For the first three weeks of school, students will login to Canvas daily. To login, students will need their student ID #. Please contact our school if you do not know your child's student ID #. Students will have recorded lessons daily with assignments to complete. Students will turn in assignments to teachers. Assignments will be graded, and student attendance will be monitored by classroom teachers.

Recorded lessons will include math, English Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, Art, Physical Education, Library/Media and social and emotional learning opportunities (like tips for managing stress and getting to know you activities). Rankin teachers will contact students daily through phone calls, messages and small group sessions. We will also have additional Student Support Team staff providing support and resources as well to assist all students during remote learning the first nine weeks. Live daily online instruction will begin September 8th and families will receive more details on the next six weeks of remote learning during their student orientation appointment. Students Receiving Special Education Services

Parents who need to request Individualized Education Plan (IEP) meetings or schedule time for related services appointments (like occupational therapy and physical therapy) that cannot be provided remotely should contact our school.

GCS will send out 125 smart buses with internet access while students are participating in remote learning. Buses will be located at various sites throughout Greensboro and High Point. Where to Get School Meals/Free and Reduced Lunch Applications

Starting September 1st, GCS students or the parent/guardian of a GCS student can pick up meals at all schools. Times of services will be announced prior to September 1st.
