## What We Offer



- Average high school class size of 15 students
- Non-traditional schedule – 11:00am-5:15pm
- Early Calendar – school year typically begins the first week of August and ends the last week of May
- Accelerated course of study – honors level high school courses and college courses leading to a college degree
- Academic support, college/career exploration and preparation, combined with social-emotional learning
- College classes and college textbooks provided at no cost
- Access to a wide variety of GTCC degree options including both college transfer Associate Degrees (designed to transfer to any of the 16 UNC System schools and aligned to the student's intended major) and the Associate of Applied Science degrees (designed for students to complete and enter the career field)
