Grade Point Average (GPA)

- Any middle school classes that count for high school credit are not used in your GPA calculation. They do count towards graduation requirements.
- Each final grade carries quality points which is used in calculating your GPA. Your Weighted GPA uses the Honors/AP scale and Unweighted GPA uses the regular scale.

Regular	Honors	AP	
A = 4	A = 4.5	A = 5	
B = 3	B = 3.5	B = 4	
C = 2	C = 2.5	C = 3

- To calculate your GPA:
 - Add up the quality points for each class you've completed
 - o Divide by the total number of classes you've completed

Weighted GPA

- Add up the quality points:
 3.5+3+3.5+2.5+4+4=20.5
- Divide by the total number of classes:
 20.5/6 = 3.4167

Unweighted GPA

- Add up the regular quality points: 3+3+3+2+4+4=19
- Divide by the total number of classes: 19/6 = 3.1667
