- 1) Jacob Donnie Green Educational Scholarship - \$TBD (Deadline April 3, 2023)
 - A) Be a Male Senior who plans to attend a 2 or 4 year college
 - B) Must complete application and turn in to Ms. Bostick or Ms. Davis:

- 2) NC Community College Grant- \$2,200 (Rolling Deadline)
 - a. Must be an NC Resident
 - b. Enroll for at least 6 credit hours per semester in a curriculum program
 - c. Meet the Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements of the institution
 - d. Must Complete the FAFSA <https://www.cfnc.org/pay-for-college/apply-for-financial-aid/nc-community-college-grant/>
- 3) NC Education Lottery Scholarship- \$3,768 (Rolling Deadline)
 - a. Must be a NC resident
 - b. Enroll for at least 6 credit hours per semester in a curriculum program
 - c. Be admitted, enrolled and classified as an undergraduate student in matriculated status in a degree, certificate or diploma program at an eligible North Carolina institution (UNC campuses and North Carolina Community College campuses)
 - d. Meet requirements for the Federal Pell Grant (except the Expected Family Contribution (EFC) range used for Federal Pell Grant awards) e. MUST complete FAFSA

- 4) NC Need-Based scholarship- \$7,640 (Rolling Deadlines)
 - a. Be a North Carolina resident as well as a North Carolina resident student for tuition purposes, as defined by North Carolina Residency Manual
 - b. Be enrolled as an undergraduate student in at least 9 credit hours at a [qualifying private North Carolina campus](#)
 - c. Demonstrate a certain level of financial need based on calculated Expected Family Contribution (EFC) from the Free Application for Federal

Student Aid (FAFSA)

- d. Meet requirements for the Federal Pell Grant (except the EFC range used for Federal Pell Grant awards) e. Must complete FAFSA

5) NC Reach- Amount Varies (Rolling Deadline)

- a. Have either been adopted from NC Division of Social Services (DSS) foster care after the age of 12, or aged out of NC DSS foster care at age 18

(must have been in care on their 18th birthday)

- b. Must be an NC Resident, eligible for in-state tuition rates

- c. Enroll at either a state community college or one of the 16 institutions of the University of North Carolina system, at least half time, pursuing an undergraduate degree, diploma, or certificate

6) Rainbow Scholarship- \$10,000 (January 20)

- a. U.S. citizen, permanent resident, or DACA student
b. Currently enrolled as an undergraduate at a U.S. university or college
c. Program of student must be eligible for credit

7) Advocates for African Americans Carolinas Scholarship- \$2,000 (March 4th 2023)

- a. must have a 3.5 GPA
b. be an American citizen
c. a member of a race/ethnic category typically considered "people of color."

- C) Have a track record of involvement and interest in AAPI communities, issues, or causes
- D) Have demonstrated financial need for the scholarship
- E) Be a US citizen, resident or foreign national

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Must be a minority

B) Must have at least a 2.0 GPA

C) Must exhibit financial need

D) Must plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college

17) The John R. Kernodle, Jr. Memorial Scholarship- up to a maximum of \$10,000 Deadline: January 27, 2023

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) AA commitment to the field of public education

B) Breadth of interests

- C) Potential for success at the college level
- D) A commitment to community service
- E) Concern for others
- F) Extracurricular involvement
- G) Financial need will be considered but is not a deciding factor
- H) Be enrolled in a college or university as a full-time student and pursue studies leading to licensure at graduation to teach in North Carolina public schools.
- I) Maintain a 3.0 GPA throughout college. If a recipient fails to do so, he/she will be required to repay all funds paid to date that were received from the John R. Kernodle, Jr. Scholarship Fund.
- J) Achieve a degree for employment as a teacher in grades K-12 or the recipient will be required to repay all funds received from the John R. Kernodle, Jr. Scholarship Fund.
- K) Meet the three-year teaching commitment or the recipient will be required to repay all funds received from the John R. Kernodle, Jr. Scholarship Fund

- 18) The DREAM National Scholarship- amount based on tuition costs- Deadline: February 28, 2023

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Are undocumented and came to the United States before November 1, 2017, and have continuously lived in the United States since then or have DACA or TPS;
- B) Came to the United States before the age of 16 (if you were born in the U.S. – you are not eligible for our scholarship);
- C) Have significant unmet financial need;
- D) Have graduated or will graduate from a United States high school (or have earned or will earn a high school equivalency diploma) before the Fall of 2023;
- E) Graduated or will graduate with a high school GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale or have a cumulative college GPA of 2.5 or better;
- F) Intend to enroll full-time in an associate or bachelor’s degree program at a Partner College in your state in the Fall of 2023 or Spring of 2024; and
- G) Are eligible for in-state tuition at the Partner College you want to attend (not applicable if it is a private Partner College in your state).

19) PHI BETA SIGMA BETA EPSILON BOULE' SCHOLARS PROGRAM- \$2,000- Deadline: March 31, 2023

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) must have a minimum SAT score of 1200 (math and verbal combined) or a minimum composite ACT score of 25.
- B) must possess a minimum cumulative weighted grade point average of a 3.50 on a 4.00 scale
- C) must provide demonstrable evidence of their leadership, school engagement, and volunteerism or service learning in the Greensboro or Guilford County community.
- D) must compose a 500-word essay in response to a prompt located on the electronic application, and they must submit two letters of recommendation. One letter must come from a teacher at the student's current high school, and the second must come from a non-family member who can attest to the student's work ethic, leadership, attitude, and potential for future success.

20) The Future of STEM Scholars Initiative (FOSSI) Scholarship \$40,000 - Deadline January 31, 2023

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Complete or have completed high school with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (unweighted) and be entering their freshman year of college
- B) Pursue a preferred STEM degree
- C) Have interest in pursuing a career in the chemical or affiliated industries
- D) Attend a Historically Black College or University (HBCU) for the entirety of their college education
- E) Demonstrate financial need
- F) Be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.

21) Frederick C. Branch Scholarship \$,180,000 - Deadline January 31, 2023

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a US Citizen
- B) Attend a school that has an NROTC unit on campus. In North Carolina, the options are UNC Chapel Hill, Duke, and NC State.
- C) Must score at least a 74 on the ASAB, or a 1000 on the SAT or a 22 on the ACT

- D) Must pass a Marine Corps Physical Fitness Test that consists of pull-ups, a plank hold, and a 3 mile run.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be an African-American female or male graduating high school senior
- B) Must have a cumulative unweighted Grade Point Average of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale
- C) Must be a US Citizen
- D) Complete application by February 17, 2023
- E) Must demonstrate leadership experience
- F) Must have participated in community service
- G) Must submit a typed essay of no more than 300 words explaining how the scholarship will benefit her or him as they prepare for the future. The font must be at least "12"
- H) Must submit three letters of recommendation from instructors, counselor, employer, or church members.

23) NC Alpha Delta Kappa Student Achievement Scholarship \$2,000 - Deadline March 1,2023

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating senior of an accredited North Carolina High School pursuing a degree at a school or higher learning, either a 2 year or 4 year college or university
- B) Have an unweighted GPA of 2.5 to 3.5
- C) An SAT score of 990 to 1130 or an ACT composite score of 20 to 24
- D) Applicants are also judged based on their service to school, community and church, as well as their good character, integrity and leadership potential.

31) Bill & Suzanne Lowe Family Foundation (2) \$5,500 Deadline April 15, 2023

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating high school senior or have graduated within the last two years prior to application submission.**
- B) • Be a resident of either Davidson or Guilford County North Carolina and must be a U.S. citizen.**
- C) • Have at least a 2.0 (“C”) grade point average (GPA) or have graduated with at least a 2.0 (“C”) grade point average.**
- D) • Demonstrate verifiable financial need including FAFSA/SAR (student aid report) and student or parent tax documents. Household income cannot exceed \$75,000 to qualify.**
- E) • Maintain a minimum of a 2.5 GPA while enrolled**
- F) Applicant must be accepted by an accredited Trade or Vocational School.**
