

Virtual Volunteer Opportunities from the Greensboro Public Library (GPL)

Share the GPL Library FB page, Instagram, Twitter, or website with your friends. Each time you share and comment, keep track and email me what you shared. **Each post you share is worth 30 minutes of volunteer time no matter how many people you share it with.**

There are also videos posted on Facebook and Instagram. You can share these with friends or family members you may know with an interest in the content. You are not limited to just sharing with friends and family in Greensboro. Let everyone know GPL is fabulous! Remember share and comment.

You can also write a book review for your latest Y or YA book you have read or something on your school reading list. Submit to me. Each book review must be all original content, no borrowing from other reviewers. Tell how the book made you feel, who would like to read this book, and a little of the content, but do not give too many details away. Also, if you can link it to another book you have read like "If you liked Lord of the Rings, you will like John Flanagan's Ranger's Apprentice". **Each book review is worth 1 hour of volunteer time.**

If I send you an informational email, you can share it for **30 minutes of volunteer time, again no matter how many you share it with it is only worth 30 minutes.**

Cook your favorite recipe and email the recipe typed and one picture of the finished recipe. **This is worth 1 hour of volunteer time.**

If you join us for the teen book club, Caffe YA, on Zoom which is usually every third Tuesday evening at 7 pm. **That is worth 1 hour of time.** If you are interested let me know so I can get you on the email list for the book club.

The weekly cap of volunteer time earned is 6 hours. Meaning you can earn up to 6 hours of time each week, if you go over you will not get credit for the overage. A week is from Sunday to Saturday. You will have to keep track of your hours and email me when you have completed a task or once a week with a list of tasks completed during the week. Your emails allow me to write your service in the volunteer notebook. I go by what is in the notebook to verify hours on x2vol or with your guidance counselor.
