Dress Code:

Students are expected to dress in a manner which is not disruptive or distracting to others. If it causes a disruption, it is inappropriate. The following rules of dress will apply:

- Your mask should be worn at all times except while eating and drinking.
- Blouses, shirts and other types of tops should extend to the top of the pants or skirt at all times.
- Shorts, skirts and dresses should extend to the bottom of the student's fingertips. This includes holes in jeans; if holes are above the fingertips, leggings must be worn. Uncovered holes are only allowed below the fingertips.
- Spaghetti straps, halter tops, fishnet or other mesh clothing, or other tops with openings that reveal inappropriate body parts or underclothing should not be worn.
- Pants that are baggy or sagging (pants/shorts must be worn around the waist) are not appropriate.
- Undergarments should not be visible while the student is standing or sitting. This includes gym shorts underneath pants.
- Sleepwear (pajama tops or bottoms) or bedroom slippers are not allowed.
- Bare feet, slides, and/or flip flops are not allowed for safety reasons. Shoes must have a heel strap or support that is utilized.
- Head apparel (hats, hoods, scarves, bonnets, du-rags, bandanas, picks, combs, etc.) or sunglasses may not be worn inside the building unless the headgear is worn based on a sincerely-held religious belief.
- Students are not permitted to wear clothing (or jewelry) that contains advertisements for tobacco, alcohol, or drugs. Clothing (or jewelry) with pictures or words depicting racism or violence is not appropriate. These include items which show knives, guns, blood, offensive messages, sexually explicit messages, or any violent theme.
- Items that are potentially dangerous such as large chains, fish hooks, and spiked objects are also not allowed.

If a student's dress, appearance, or lack of cleanliness is detrimental to the health or safety of the student or others, substantially disrupts the school or work environment, or otherwise violates this policy, the principal may require the student to adjust their appearance or clothing. Failure to comply with this policy or the school dress code will result in the student being removed from the classroom and/or school until the student's appearance or clothing meets the school district policy or rules. The student's parent/guardian will be notified prior to any removal from school. Thank you for your cooperation.
