Description of Course:

Prerequisite: 7242 Health Science 2

This course is designed to help students expand their understanding of financing and trends of health care agencies, fundamentals of wellness, legal and ethical issues, concepts of teamwork, and effective communication. Students will learn health care skills, including current CPR and first aid training. English language arts and science are reinforced in this course. Apprenticeship and cooperative education are not available for this course. Community service and leadership activities provide the opportunity to apply essential standards and workplace readiness skills through authentic experiences.

Notebooks are required in class daily. Additional items may be required. Notebooks should include the following: all classroom expectations, course content, all written assignments, worksheets, vocabulary, and test/quizzes. There will be periodic notebooks and graded based on the rubric provided.

There will be a major test after we have completed each unit. It will be announced and written on the board. There will be quizzes/assessments once a week in order to evaluate the student's progress in day-to-day work. If a student has been absent and a test was announced on a day the student was present, the student is expected to take the test on its regularly scheduled day unless there are extenuating circumstances. It is the student's responsibility to check with the teacher before or after school or with a classmate about missed assignments or lecture notes. Daily assessments will be evaluated based on material covered in class and on homework assignments.

Homework Policy:

1. All homework assignments must be submitted at the beginning of class.
2. Late paperwork will **NOT** be accepted for full credit. (If you are absent the day homework is collected, it must be turned in the same day you return (no exceptions).
3. Only completed homework will receive a complete grade. (If you do not understand the homework assignment, it is your responsibility to ask for clarification before homework is due).
4. All work must be submitted on time with the student's name, class period, and date in the top right corner. Work left at home will either not be accepted or have points deducted.

Make-up Work Policy: Students are required to submit make-up work for excused absences within five school days. Make-up work for unexcused absences is at the teacher's discretion.

Any late work must be completed within 5 days of the absence. It is the student's responsibility to obtain, complete, and turn in any missed assignments!!

Attendance Policy: Students are expected to be in class on time each day of school. After 4 absences you will be required to make up the time to avoid no credit status for the class.

Behavioral Expectations:

1. Follow all school expectations.
2. Follow the class expectations:

- a) Students are to be in their seats with required materials and ready to work when the tardy bell rings.
- b) Students are to follow directions the first time they are given.
- c) Students are expected to demonstrate standards of respect for themselves, others, and equipment.
- d) The students are expected to remain in their seats unless instructed to do otherwise. Raise your hand for permission to speak and /or move about within the room.
- e) No food or drink in the classroom (except for 1st block breakfast in the classroom) unless otherwise stated.
- f) No personal grooming during class. Hair combing, etc. should be done between classes.
- g) Students are expected to use the restroom before and after class.
- h) CHEATING will NOT be TOLERATED! If a student is caught cheating, they will receive a zero on that assignment and parents will be notified!
- i) Students will use words that are acceptable at school (no profanity).
- j) Students should be dress according to the School Dress Code every day, no exceptions.
- k) NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES ALLOWED IN THE CLASSROOM. Electronic devices are to be out of site, off or on silent/vibrate mode once in the classroom. Student will be given ONE verbal warning for first offence, SECOND offense student will be asked for electronic device. Teacher will hold on to electronic device for the remainder of the class and return to student once the bell rings. Parent contact and further disciplinary action if student habitually does not adhere to electronic device policy.
- l) The teacher has the option of changing or adding to any of the above expectations.

Consequences for not following expectations and regulations:

- 1st Offense: Warning/parent contact
- 2nd Offense: Call or parent conference
- 3rd Offense: Discipline referral to administration

Any major offenses, (fighting, arguing, disrespect) will be addressed immediately and administrators will be notified at once.
