Senior Painted Parking Spaces

Packet Due: Friday, October 8th

Painting Days: October 23rd-26th

Cost: \$15 (This is in addition to the school parking permit)

- **Step 1:** Pick up a packet in the school's main office or download it from the WGHS Homepage.
- **Step 2:** Fill in the packet and include a copy of the design for your parking space.
 - Your design must be clearly drawn on this form and must include the colors you will be using in your parking space. **NO CHANGES will be allowed on painting day!**
 - We will keep the copy of your drawing, so make a copy for yourself as well.
- **Step 3:** Return the packet and \$15 cash or check made out to: WGHS Boosters to Ms. Nosal by: **Friday, October 8th**
- **Step 4:** Once your design has been reviewed, you will receive an email or call ONLY if your design is unacceptable and changes need to be made. If you have NOT been contacted by Friday, October 15th, you can assume that your design has been approved.

Painting Requirements

- Paint must be water-based interior/exterior latex paint.
- DO NOT cover the white lines, front curb/bumper block, or number of the parking space. Students must leave 4 inches between the white lines and the design. It is advisable to tape this border off prior to painting. It takes about 2 gallons if you want to do a base coat before painting your design. Old paint works very well.
- NO spray, fluorescent, reflective, glitter, oil based, or other types of paint allowed.
- NO offensive language, pictures, flags, or symbols.
- NO negative or rude language.
- NO symbols related to gang-activity or gang-style tagging.
- NO double meanings, nicknames, girlfriend/boyfriend names, names of other students, etc. Only your own name will be allowed.
- You are REQUIRED to paint over your space with black paint at the end of the year before graduation. If you fail to paint over your space, you will incur a \$15 fine.

Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Administration and you will forfeit your right to a parking space. Your money will not be refunded.

On Painting Day

- Painting Days: Saturday, October 23rd- Tuesday, October 26th from 8:30am – 4:30pm.
 - If you will be out of town on painting days, please contact Ms. Nosal at nosals@gcsnc.com
- Check-in at the Senior Parent table in the parking lot when you arrive.
- You will need:
 - A copy of your design.
 - A photo id, your parking pass, and a receipt showing that you paid for the Painting Privileges.
 - Newspapers, tarps, tape, or something to block off the rest of the parking space so paint will not get on anything other than your designated space.
 - A broom to sweep your space before you begin.
 - Paint brushes, paint, painter's tape, a bucket of water, and any other supplies you might need.
 - Wear sunscreen and bring bottled water.

Suggested Materials, Tips, and Hints

- Check-in upon arrival with approved design, receipt of payment, photo id, and parking pass.
- Water-based primer paint/base coat if desired. (It will take about 2 gallons for a base coat.)
- Paint can be expensive, ask family and friends for extra paint to donate. Consider limiting the number of colors in your design or share paint with friends.
- Use chalk to sketch your design first.
- Bring paint brushes and/or rollers – try to use a roller with an extension handle for the base coat.
- Paint pans and plastic containers for water, brushes, paint, and wooden stirrers
- 4-inch wide Blue painter's tape to mark off spot
- Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans (Remember: paint can't be erased)
- Broom to sweep spot
- Old cloths or paper towels
- Trash bags
- Sunshade, sunscreen, umbrellas, sunglasses, hats, pop-up canopy to block sun
- Water and snacks
- Lawn chairs, stools, towel to sit on
- People to help you!

I hereby agree to abide by all of the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved painted parking space:

1. Upon purchasing my parking space, I will use only water-based interior/exterior paint.
2. I understand that I must check-in at the Senior Parent table before I begin painting.
3. I know that I am not allowed to use spray, fluorescent, reflective, glitter, or oil-based paint.
4. I will only paint within the marked parking space, leaving 4 inches of space between my design and the white lines.
5. I know I must bring my own brushes and painting supplies to decorate my space.
6. I will only paint my approved design following all the guidelines. I will not add anything to my parking lot space after painting day.
7. If I do not abide by the rules, I realize that my parking space will be taken away, painted over, and I will not receive a refund.
8. I know that parking in someone else's parking space or letting anyone else park in my space may result in disciplinary action.
9. I agree to paint over my design using black paint at the end of the year or pay a fine of \$15.
