This year we will be focusing on the Elements and Principles of Art. The Elements and Principles of Art are the building blocks and organization of a work of art. Art History, Art Criticism and Art Analysis will also be a focus.

Required Materials:

- ⇒ Pencils, erasers, handheld pencil sharpeners
- ⇒ Sketchbooks at least 8.5x11 in. **or paper with no lines**
- ⇒ Recommended but not required: sharpie, personal paint sets, markers etc.

Student Expectations

- ⇒ Students must log into my class every day, even if an assignment is not due, to check announcements.
- ⇒ Students are to work on art projects every day – the suggested time to work on art is 30 minutes a day.
- ⇒ **Live sessions, group discussions and peer critique:** students are to be courteous and respectful of the teacher and other students.
- ⇒ Students are to try their best! Time and effort must be evident (in other words, turning in scribbles, something rushed, or turning in something for the sake of something will be marked as incomplete until the assignment is resubmitted)
- ⇒ Students are expected to turn in their own work. Otherwise this is considered plagiarism. See what is considered as plagiarism in the right column.

What Does Plagiarism Look Like in the Art Classroom?

- ⇒ Copying or stealing other's work or ideas (written and visual)
- ⇒ Creating works of art using copyrighted characters or imagery (unless otherwise approved)*
- ⇒ Having another person draw or color part or all of the artwork
- ⇒ Copying and pasting an image found on the internet and submitting it as their own work
 - Reverse google image search can be used by the teacher

*There are times that copying another artwork is allowed, **but this will be specifically stated by the teacher when it is allowed.** Copying another artwork can be a form of learning, but credit to the original artist **MUST** be stated.

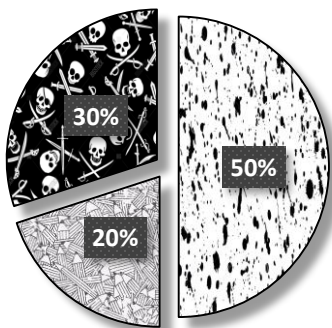
Attendance to my class is taken daily through Canvas reports.
