Dear Red Raider families,

Guilford County Schools is implementing a new student ID card called the GCS OneCard. Our students will be receiving the OneCard on September 11, 2019, and all students will be expected to display the card on a lanyard provided by the district beginning on September 12, 2019.

Students will be required to wear the ID card at all times while they are on campus and will scan the card when entering the building each day. This is an important safety measure that will help us know who is in our buildings. The card also makes it more convenient for students to check out library books and to purchase meals from our cafeteria. In the future, it will be used to enter and exit busses and check out library books from the local public libraries.

Wearing the card is mandatory for all students, so please remind your student to wear his or her card as we transition to this new procedure. Students who do not have their cards will be subject to consequences, which may include a call home, detention or in-school suspension.
