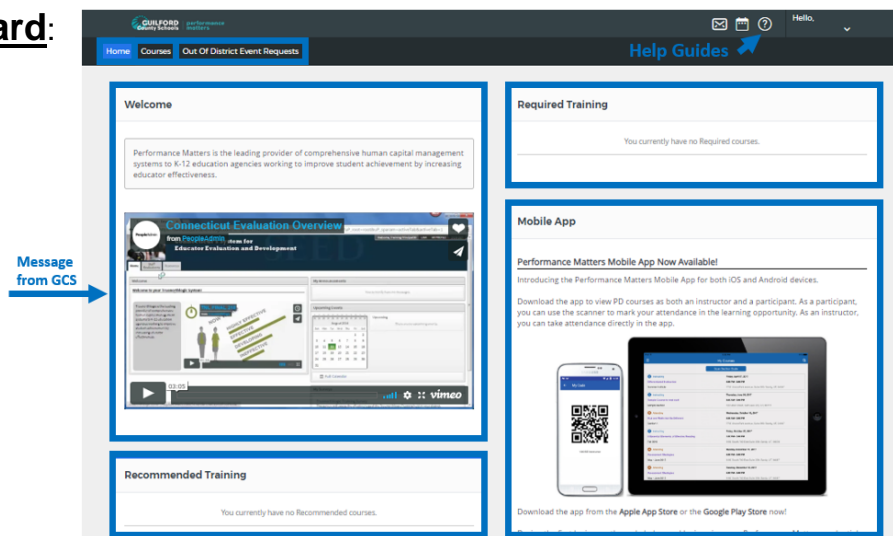

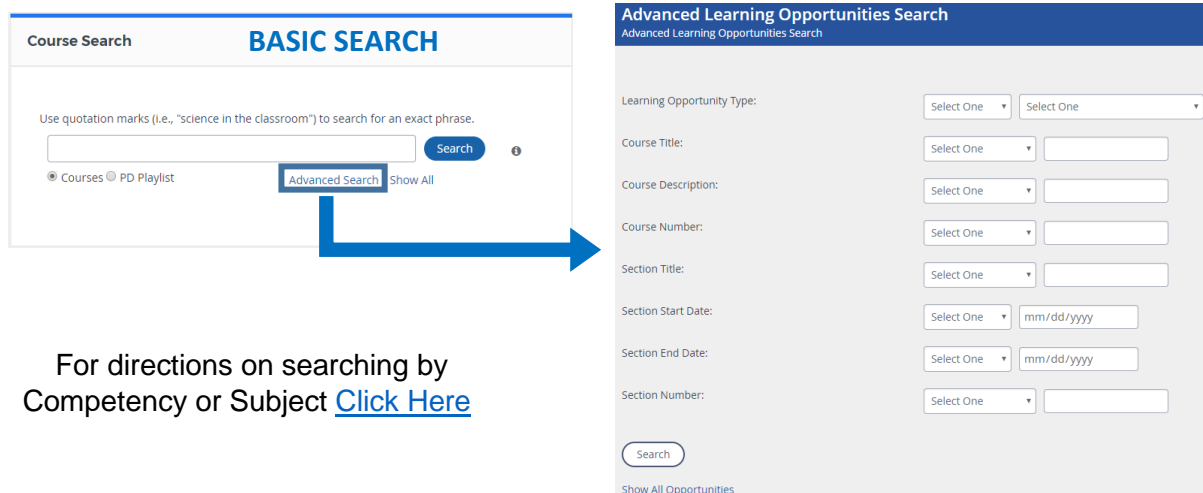

Home Courses **Out Of District Event Requests**

Out of District Event Request(s) Information

After you have completed your non-GCS event class, you must submit an out of district event request and upload a copy of your certificate of completion or course transcript.

Note the following important points regarding renewal credits:

- CEU credit cannot be awarded for any course with less than 5 hours of instruction. CEUs are granted for no more than 6 hours of staff development per day.
- CEUs are awarded based on the number of hours of training:
 - five hours = .5 CEUs
 - six hours = .6 CEUs
 - ten hours = 1.0 CEUs, etc.
- Conferences, college classes, on-line courses and Teacher Academy courses are examples of classes that would qualify as events you could enter as an out of district event request.
