Membership Criteria

Membership in the National Honor Society at Southeast High School is based on leadership, service, scholarship and character. All students with an unweighted GPA of 3.5 are invited to complete the activity form for NHS during the junior year of high school.

The student who exercises leadership:

- Takes a constructive lead in classroom, school, and community activities
- Successfully holds school/community offices or positions of responsibility
- Contributes constructive ideas which improve the school
- Examples: student body, class, or club officer; committee chair; team captain/manager; Eagle/Silver Scout; GYC officer

The student who serves:

- Volunteers dependable and well-organized assistance, is gladly available, and is willing to sacrifice to offer assistance
- Does committee and staff work willingly
- Serves on projects which serve others (not including immediate family members) for which they are not paid
- Examples: food or clothing drive sponsored by a school club; participation in a blood drive; participation in a walk-a-thon for cancer, diabetes, or hunger; peer tutoring; Greensboro Youth Council projects; mission work for a church; nursing home projects; Soup Kitchen; Urban Ministries; Boy/Girl Scout projects; musicals. - Cooperates in a willing spirit with school regulations
- Demonstrates the highest standards of honesty and reliability
- Upholds principles of morality and ethics
