

The Middle College at UNCG—Dress Code Basics

*****During the first three days of school, we will be exploring our building & the UNCG campus. Please wear comfortable shoes that you don't mind walking in, climbing stairs in, etc.*****

Tops	Bottoms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • T-shirts, collared shirts, button-downs or hoodies of any color, plain or with school-appropriate designs. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Hoods are not to be worn inside the building. ○ Shirts with language/graphics that could be considered derogatory, violent, etc. are not allowed. • All tops must completely cover the chest, undergarments, and midriff areas. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Revealing shirts (spaghetti straps, midriff tops, light colored shirts with visible undergarments) are not allowed. • Sheer tops must be worn with a wide-strap tank top, that fully covers all parts of undergarments. • If wearing a jacket, your shirt must be dress-code appropriate. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For all types of bottoms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Must be worn at the waist, always, regardless of type of bottom. ○ Should have hemlines/splits no higher than 4" from above the crease at the back of the knee. ○ Should not be overly form-fitting or tight. • Jeans or khakis (special event days) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Pants with rips 4" from the knee or above, must be worn with leggings or tights underneath. • Sweatpants <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ UNCG, Middle College at UNCG, or plain ○ If sweats have a logo, must be no larger than a business card ○ UNCG/MC at UNCG logos of any size are allowed
Shoes & Accessories	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Head-coverings (including hoodie tops) are not allowed, unless for religious reasons <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All other hats/head-coverings are to be removed upon entering the building • Wear comfortable shoes! You'll be walking a lot. Slides, crocs, and sandals are allowed. But make sure your shoes are safe and comfortable for the activities of that day. Bedroom slippers are not allowed. 	
Pathways	
Students dress in professional attire when off campus for Pathways-related experiences. More specific details will be provided by Pathways instructors.	

Specific consequences for dress code infractions will be covered during the first two days of school.
