

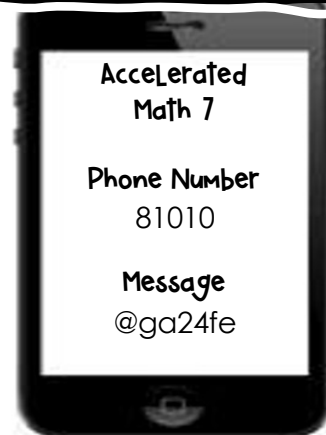

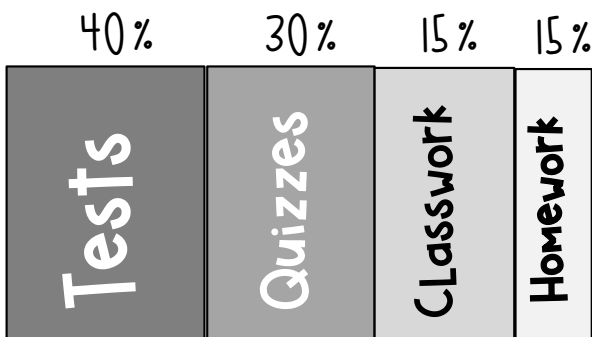
Absent Work

If you are **absent**, you are responsible for finding your missed work in the absent work bin on the counter. You have 3 school days to complete all your missing work and show it to the teacher. If work is submitted after the 3-day time frame, the highest grade possible will be 70% for the assignment. You need to put notes into your interactive notebook. Use notes and help videos on Canvas to help you make up work.

Late Work

All canvas assignments are open for 3 days with a late penalty; therefore, work should be turned in on its due date. Late work will lose points on a per-day-late basis. Missing assignments (after the unit test) will result in a zero for the assignment. Come prepared to class with your binder, planner, pencils, interactive notebook, and homework everyday.

Homework

Tests & Quizzes

Each **Friday** you will have a short **Quiz** covering what was learned that week. At the end of each unit, you will take a unit post-assessment **Test**. It is your responsibility to study your interactive notebook notes and watch the help videos posted in Canvas to help you study for upcoming quizzes and tests.

If you are absent for a test or quiz, you will need to make it up by scheduling a time to come during the morning before the start of the school day.

Corrections Directions –

1. On notebook paper, rework the problem(s) missed, showing detailed work to support the correct answer(s).
2. Write one sentence explaining what you did wrong originally.
