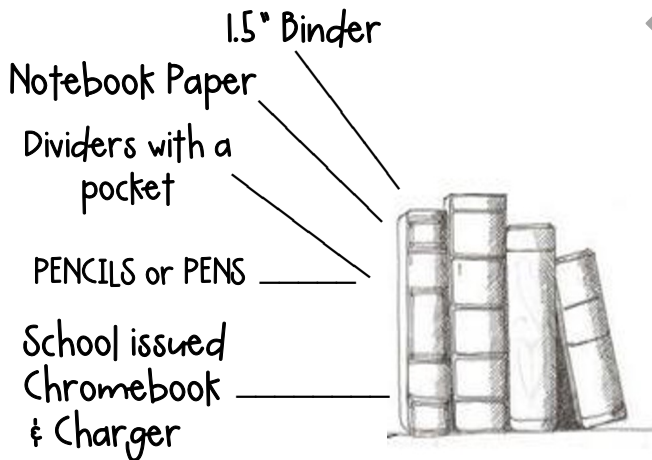

Course Description
