Our program with Guilford Technical Community College (GTCC) allows qualifying students to enroll in college courses for dual credit in the 11th and 12th grades. The GTCC courses are transferable to the colleges and universities in the North Carolina University System. Kearns Academy offers students the opportunity to grow and develop relationships with teachers, as class sizes are typically small. Entering freshmen take courses in computer programming and computer science to build a foundation to launch a career in one of the fastest growing fields.
