Click More Options under search. You can choose only available titles; format (book or audio); compatibility (Libby or Kindle); and audience (Young Adult).

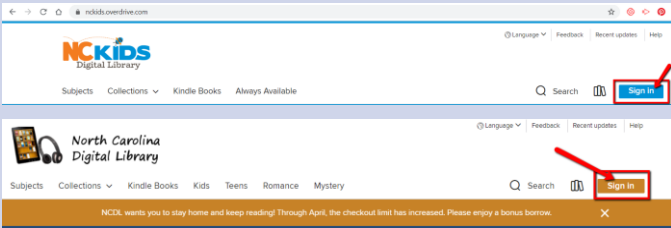




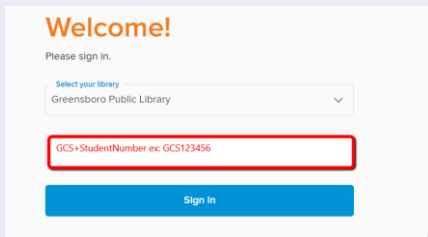
