

# Learning Responsibilities

## 5<sup>th</sup> Grade

### Attendances/Tardies:

Attendance will be taken daily. A student is considered tardy if they are not in the **classroom** when the bell rings at 7:25. Please be sure to send a note for all absences. If you know of an absence in advance, please let us know so we can prepare work for your child to prevent falling behind. Vacations require a note to be approved by the principal in advance. Majority of our instruction will happen between 7:30-11:30am. Please try to protect this time.

### Homework:

- Reading - Read 30 minutes nightly
- Math - Nightly lesson practice
- Unfinished classwork
- Other as assigned by teachers. Check CANVAS/planner.

Homework grades are based on completion. 100% for complete and on time (must try all questions), 50% for late or incomplete, 0% missing (after 3 days)..

### Missing/Late Assignments:

A **late** assignment includes:

1. Incomplete assignment.
2. Leaving assignments/supplies at home.
3. Not taking home needed materials to complete an assignment

Late assignments will receive **half** credit unless otherwise noted in the assignment.

An assignment is considered **missing** if not turned in within 3 days of the expected due date and will receive a **zero**.

### Communication:

Students can communicate questions with teachers using their Canvas inbox.

### Grading Scale:

Tests - 40%	A = 90%-100%
Quizzes - 30%	B = 80%-89%
Classwork - 20%	C = 70%-79%
Homework - 10%	D = 60%-69%
	F = <60%

\* Notes can be used on quizzes and classwork; no retakes will be allowed.

\*\* Notes cannot be used on Math/Science tests. Students must study for tests.

\*\*Test corrections can be completed for half credit on all tests.

\*Extra credit is not offered since notes can be used on quizzes and tests are announced in advance with adequate time to study and prepare.

### PowerSchool:

Report card grades are found on **PowerSchool**. This will be updated weekly. Please check grades and assignments regularly, not just at interims and report cards. Canvas grades are **not** calculated in the same manner and should not be used when considering report card grades. This is a tool to check assignment scores and look for missing assignments.
