COMMITMENT FROM OUR SCHOOL

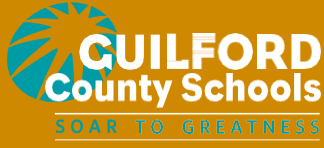
We are committed to:
