Respects property of others and authority of those who administer the competition. Respects the integrity and judgment of game officials. Understands that they are doing their best to help promote the student/athlete and admire their willingness to participate in full view of the public.

Only brings clear bags into the games, in accordance with GCS policy.

Sits in the stands during the games and does not gather near entrances, steps, or fences. There is no loitering, no fighting and no foul language.

Students being picked up must have a ride within 15 minutes following the conclusion of the game.
