Good evening Wildcat Families, this is Principal McNeill with your weekly update. I hope that everyone had a great weekend. I have a lot of information to give you this evening, so please listen to this message in its entirety.

As a reminder, the first day of school is August 15th. Students can begin arriving as early as 8 am. The instructional day is from 8:20 to 3:20. We are excited about welcoming our families to open house on August 11th. 6th graders are invited to come from 5:30 to 6:30 and 7th and 8th graders are invited to come from 6:30 to 7:30. Schedules will be mailed home Friday.

Teachers will provide supply list during open house. Until then, you may want to pick up 4 spiral notebooks, a 3-ring binder, loose leaf paper, pencils, pens, highlighters and Kleenex.

As you begin back to school clothes shopping, I would like to bring to your attention Eastern's dress code: shorts, skirts, dresses and skorts should not be higher than mid-thigh. If your student is wearing shorts or jeans with holes, we ask that the holes are no higher than mid-thigh or students should have tights or leggings underneath. Lastly, shirts should come down to your student's waist, their mid-section should not be visible.

If you have a 7th grader, he or she is required to get an updated Tdap and MCV vaccines. It is state law for all seventh-graders to have the vaccines at the start of the school year, so please take time now to schedule an appointment with your health care provider.

If your student will be taking medicine while at school, an authorization of medicine must be completed by your health care provider.
