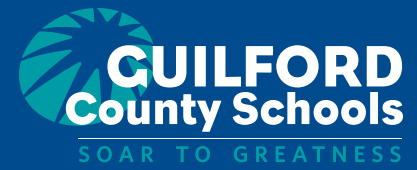

Majors available:

- Integrated Production Technology
- Mechanical Engineering

Post-graduation potential:

- Graduates are prepared for college majors such as engineering, manufacturing and business.
- Students desiring to go to work immediately have training and credentials for jobs such as fabricator, machinist or engineer.
- Salary potential ranges from \$35,000 per year for sheet metal workers to \$93,000 for electrical engineers.
