

Weaver National Honor Society Criteria for Membership 2024-2025

The National Honor Society is an organization which recognizes outstanding achievement in the following 4 areas:

1. Scholarship
 - a. Invited Juniors - the minimum is a weighted GPA of 4.3 due to the addition of AP Precalculus.
 - b. Invited Seniors – the minimum is a weighted GPA of 4.1.
2. Leadership
3. Character
4. Service

Membership is an honor, not a privilege, and is based on a student's overall achievement in these 4 areas. The GPA alone does not guarantee membership.

A student **MUST** have been enrolled at Weaver Academy, as a PVA student, for at least **one semester** before he/she is eligible for membership in NHS. A student must be a member of the junior or senior class. The application must be completed online.

A completed application packet will include:

- a) **Application**
- b) **Student resume**
- c) **Character assessment**
- d) **Teacher recommendation forms from your Spring 2024 teachers.**

In addition to GPA, the students will be reviewed in the following three areas by the Faculty Council.

- Character, Leadership and Service
- Each area is graded on a 5-point scale with totals used as described below.

Applications will be reviewed blindly by the Faculty Council in a private meeting. The total points awarded will determine membership as follows:

- 12-15 Points – Applicant is Accepted
- 9-11 Points – Application will be reviewed by the Faculty Council. The Council will vote on membership for the students. The students must have a majority vote by the Faculty Council for consideration for membership.
- Below 9 Points – Applicant is Not Accepted. If they are a Junior, they may have the opportunity to apply in the fall of their Senior year.

Weaver Academy has one induction ceremony per year in the Fall Semester.
