- Students have access to college tutoring as needed.
- Students have multiple opportunities to participate in service throughout the triad.

Why Choose the Middle College at GTCC – High Point?!?!

No GPA requirement. Students receive directed remediation before taking the college placement test
Students begin taking classes during their 9 th grade year to be able to complete a degree
Students can stay a 5 th year to complete their degree or certificate track
Personalized small classes with average student teacher ratio no more than 15 to 1
Gain a college experience while taking high school classes
Individualized college mentorship to support college academic success

The application window begins at the GCS Magnet Showcase. We will receive applications for one month from that date. Applications are available through the GCS website. Students interested in attending the middle college will be required to attend an informational session. During this time, MCHP will offer tours of our campus and open houses.
