

Learning Responsibilities

Attendance:

Attendance will be taken daily; a student is considered tardy if they are not in the classroom when the bell rings at 7:25. Please be sure to send a written, signed note for all absences. You are welcome to let us know via email if your child will be out, but we must have a written note for documentation and to be excused. Vacations are not considered excused absences. Students will need to explain educational opportunities and complete work if a vacation is taken during the school year.

Missing/late Assignments:

All late assignments will receive half credit unless otherwise noted. An assignment is considered missing if not turned in within 3 days of the expected due date. Missing assignments will receive a zero.

Canvas:

We will continue to utilize Canvas throughout the school year. Most classwork, homework, tests, quizzes, etc. will be located on Canvas. When absent, students should check Canvas for assignments. Students should check and use the Canvas "Inbox" to communicate with their teachers.

Grading Scale:

Tests - 40%	A = 90%-100%
Quizzes - 30%	B = 80%-89%
Classwork - 20%	C = 70%-79%
Homework - 10%	D = 60%-69%
	F = <60%

* Notes can be used on quizzes and no retakes will be allowed.

** Notes cannot be used on math or science tests. Students must study for these tests. Test corrections can be completed for half credit in all subjects.

*Extra credit is not offered.

PowerSchool:

Report card grades are found on PowerSchool. This will be updated weekly. Please check grades and assignments regularly, not just at interims and report cards. Canvas grades are not calculated in the same manner and should not be used when considering report card grades. This is a tool to check assignment scores and look for missing assignments.
