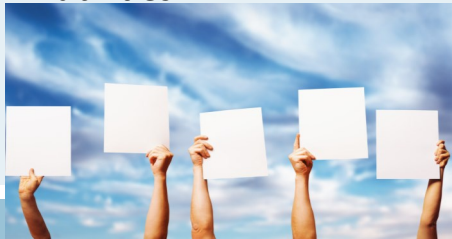


Outcomes:
