The following standard mode of dress will be required of all students at Jackson Middle School for the 2018-2019 school year. As you shop for school clothes, please follow the guidelines below. Pay close attention to fabrics. No form-fitting garments that cause distractions will be allowed.

Tops:

 <p>Polo shirt/ Golf Shirt (short- or long-sleeved)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must have a collar • Must be long enough to be tucked in at all times • Short or long-sleeved • Must be buttoned and worn appropriately • Shirts worn underneath may not have a collar (for example, layering two polo shirts) • Must be solid in color and manufacturer's emblem may be no larger than credit card sized. • NO DESIGNS ON SHIRTS 	 <p>Vest. Jacket. Fleece. Sweatshirt</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be grey for 6th grade, green for 7th grade, and black for 8th grade. • Must be solid in color and grade level color • Must be worn over an approved collared dress code shirt • May have a round or V-neck, or it may be cardigan styled; front may be plain, buttoned, or zippered. • If a light-weight jacket/fleeces/sweater/sweatshirt/vest meets the above guideline. • Jacket/fleeces/sweater/sweatshirt/vest meeting the above criteria may not be any longer than the wrist.
 <p>Underclothes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Undershirts and leggings must be in solid colors only • Leggings may only be worn as undergarments 	<p>Miscellaneous:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Clothing must be worn so as not to pose a distraction <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Example: no immodestly open shirts, no low-cut tops, or hip-hugging pants, capris, skirts, or shorts.

Bottoms:

 <p>Pants</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flat front or pleated "Chino" style twill with straight leg Bottoms including denim may only be: black, grey, tan, navy, or blue <p>Khaki</p>  <p>Corduroy</p>	 <p>Shorts (Khaki or Denim)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flat front or pleated "Chino" style twill Bottoms including denim may only be: black, grey, tan, navy, or blue Should be worn at the knee or longer (walking / Bermuda style) 	  <p>Skirt or Skort</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flat front or pleated "Chino" style twill Knee length or longer Must be worn within the dress code colors: black, grey, tan, navy, or blue 	 <p>Capris</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flat front or pleated "Chino" style twill Mid-calf to knee length Cannot be hip huggers, skin tight, and the manufactured slit at the bottom of the Capri pant cannot be above the knee
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- Must be worn **at the waist at all times** and fit to size (not baggy/skin tight)
- Must be solid in color and manufacturer's emblem may be no larger than credit card sized. (black, grey, tan, blue, or navy)
- Capri pants are allowed but cannot be hip huggers, cannot be skin tight, and the manufactured slit at the bottom of the Capri pant cannot be above the knee

Not allowed:

- Form fitting spandex materials, Nylon, Oversized pants, Stripes or patterns, Jumpsuits/overalls, Holes in clothing, Cut-up or cut-off shorts, Sweat pants, Joggers, Pajama pants, Leggings or jeggings worn alone, Cannot be tucked into socks

<p>Belts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All pants, capris, shorts, and skirts must be worn at the waist Students may wear a belt if garment/clothing was manufactured with belt loops NO CHAIN BELTS Suspenders are permitted but must be worn on the shoulders at all times 	<p>Shoes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No flip-flops of any kind (including shower shoes) No net slides No bedroom slippers 	<p>Outerwear</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All outerwear must be stored in locker before entering any classroom/media center/computer lab. Outerwear includes, but is not limited to rain gear, jackets, non-SMOD approved jackets, coats, hats. Hats, any headgear and non-prescription glasses are special forms of outerwear that must be removed upon entering any school building and stored in locker. During an academic day, the cafeteria is considered to be a "school building" and a "classroom" for the purposes of enforcing the dress code. No blankets, do-rags, scarves, and bandannas are to be worn or brought on school grounds
