**Overview:**

**Qualification for Membership:**

The following information should be used as a guideline for completing the Candidate Information Form for NGHS NHS. Please be advised that a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5 (unweighted) or 4.0 (weighted) is required, but students are encouraged to have higher averages. ***Meeting the minimum GPA requirement does not guarantee membership.*** Membership is based on a student's overall achievements in ***scholarship, leadership, service and character.*** A student must attend Northern Guilford High School for at least one semester to be considered eligible. Students not admitted during their junior year, but still meeting minimum requirements, may receive a second opportunity their senior year.

**Completing the Candidate Information Form:**

*Please use the following information as a guideline. Consult a NGHS NHS Adviser if you have additional questions. Completion and submission of this form does not guarantee selection. Directions: Please complete all sections. Do not be modest. Every bit of information will be used by the faculty council to assist with the fair consideration during the selection process.*

1. Candidate Information Forms should be **completed neatly in ink or typed.** Candidate Information Forms must be completed by the student.
2. **Late Candidate Information Forms will not be considered.**
3. School/Club/Community/Leadership sponsors **must sign** to verify a student's participation in each activity. **The sponsor must include their phone number or email.** A parent's **signature may not substitute for sponsor's signature.**
4. Any information submitted after the deadline will not be considered.
5. The NGHS NHS Faculty Council may not be familiar with some of the community-related activities included on the Candidate Information Form. It is therefore **the responsibility of the candidate** to include the necessary supporting information. It must be clear how the submitted evidence supports the requirements. If a candidate is in doubt, he/she should consult with the NGHS NHS adviser prior to submitting the form. If there is not room on the form to sufficiently describe your activity/leadership role, please attach descriptions on a separate page.
6. A student is not eligible for NHS if they have been:
  - \* **suspended from high school**
  - \* **disciplined for cheating (including plagiarism) during high school**
7. If you wish to have a copy of your submission, make one before you submit it. **No copies will be released after submission.** All submissions are retained until appeal process is completed.

**Induction:**

An induction ceremony and reception will be held on a Sunday, for newly selected candidates. Parents, administrators, and teachers will be invited to attend. Selected candidates must be inducted to become members.

### **How the submission is scored:**

Candidate Information Forms submitted by the deadline will be reviewed and scored by the Faculty Council. Academic scholarship will not be revisited once a student is invited to submit a form. Therefore, scoring of the submission comes from the remaining three qualities that characterize a member of National Honor Society: **Service, Leadership, and Character.**

#### **Service: (maximum of 5 points)**

List all service-related activities that you have participated in during your high school years. **Candidates receive ½ point for each qualifying activity.** Service is generally considered actions taken by student which are done with or on behalf of others without any direct financial or material compensation to the individual performing the service.

#### **Leadership: (maximum of 5 points)**

List all elected or appointed leadership positions held in school, community, or work activities. **Candidates receive 1 point for each qualifying leadership activity. *You should only include positions in which you were directly responsible for directing or motivating others.*** Examples include elected student body, class or club officer; team captain; newspaper editor; work area manager; gold/silver awards in Girl Scouts; Eagle Scout award in Boy Scouts; or community leader. Be sure to include an explanation of the duties involved in the leadership activity. Leadership activities can be found in many areas. Do not be modest. Give a detailed list of all activities in which you think that you have displayed a leadership role. For activities outside of school, a good detailed accounting of the leadership role that you played will help the committee to make an enlightened decision.

#### **Character: (maximum of 5 points)**

Candidates receive 1 point for each NO answer to questions on the information form in the section labeled "Character". Additional points (up to 3) are earned based on faculty member evaluations of each candidate's character conducted by the chapter adviser. Points will be tallied and averaged for each candidate. Candidates receive 1 point for a 3 (average) rating; 2 points for a 4 (good) rating; and 3 points for a 5 (exceptional) rating. The Faculty Council will investigate all candidates who:

- a) Receive negative character comments on the faculty evaluation form
- b) Do not receive an overall rating of 3 on the evaluation form.

**Selection:** After carefully reviewing each submission, the Faculty Council will submit a list of students for acceptance. All candidates will be notified of their selection status via letter.

#### **Membership Obligations:**

Dues for this chapter are \$25, which includes the cost of membership card, emblem, and graduation cords for seniors. Dues will be payable to the chapter within 30 days of induction. Members not financially able to pay dues should personally contact the NGHS NHS Adviser.

Chapter members are expected to maintain academic standards, attend meetings, and participate in both individual and chapter service projects, approved by the NGHS NHS adviser, including 18 service hours per academic school year to maintain their membership in good standing.
