



Mandatory Graduation Rehearsal: Thursday, June 2 at 11 am

****Attendance at rehearsal is required to participate in the graduation ceremony.**

Greensboro Coliseum Staging Area (Enter on Special Events Center level—Do NOT take ramp up to the coliseum)

Students Arrive: 10:45 am

Practice Ends: 1:00 pm

Marshals/Ushers Arrive: 10:30am

- Do NOT need to bring cap & gown
- **Bring shoes you will wear at graduation if you need to practice.**
 - *You need to be prepared to walk over half a mile and stand over an hour in the shoes.*

GRADUATION: Saturday, June 4 at 8:00 pm

Greensboro Coliseum (Graduates report to staging area)

Students Arrive: 7:30 pm (staging area) **Processional: 8:00 pm**

Marshals/Ushers Arrive: 7:15 pm (staging area)

- When you arrive, report to the staging area to find your place in line.
- Bring cap, gown, stole, and tassel.
- Dress Options:
 - Dress pants (brown, beige, black or navy) and long-sleeved collared shirt. No tennis shoes, flip-flops, or other casual shoes.
 - Dress (no longer than gown) and shoes with a strap across the back of the foot. No tennis shoes, flip-flops, or other casual shoes.
- No decorations on cap & gown; only school provided cords are allowed.
- No purses or bags are allowed in the processional. Leave everything at home.
- **No cell phones.** If you are seen with a cell phone during the processional or ceremony, the phone will be confiscated and could result in your diploma being held.
- This is an important and formal event. Your parents & families, Dr. McKenzie, and distinguished guests deserve your respect. No loud or rude behavior. Those behaviors could result in your diploma being held.
