Important Senior Dates

- May 17 – All financial obligations to The Academy at Smith and Guilford County Schools must be paid in full.

- May 24- Graduation Rehearsal (**Mandatory**) – Tuesday, 1:00 PM, at Greensboro Coliseum – Swarm Field House. All seniors who are planning to participate in graduation are required to attend rehearsal. You do not need to bring your cap and gown to rehearsal. Graduation Tickets – Graduation Tickets will be distributed at rehearsal. Seniors will receive an envelope that contains their graduation tickets.
