May 1 st	Cap & Gown Pick Up in the Media Center <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • During all 3 lunches • 11:05am – 1:05pm • When you pick up your Cap & Gown please hang it up so the wrinkles fall out
May 1 st	Make Up Cap & Gown Pictures <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10:00am- 3:00pm • You must sign up for an appointment • <u>Senior Cap and Gown Makeups please click on this link to sign up</u> 
May 21 st	Graduation Walks <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The busses will depart at 9:45am • Students are not allowed to drive; they must ride the bus • Please pick up permission slip forms from Ms. Hyman and return no later than May 1st • Guilford County School District determines the elementary schools we visit for Graduation Walks not Eastern Guilford High School • Sedalia, McLeansville, and Gibsonville Elementary schools are our designated school • Early Graduates can participate, please turn in permission slip and plan to arrive to school no later than 9:30am to ride the bus
May 21 st	Graduation Line Up Practice <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practice is Mandatory • Practice will be in the main gym starting around 10:45 • An announcement will be made for seniors to report to the gym • Early Graduates who are not participating in the graduation walks should plan to arrive to campus by 10:40am for line up practice
May 21 st	Senior Cookout & Decision Day <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This event will be immediately following the graduation practice line up • Event time 12:00-2:45; as long as the practice line up does not run over • Students will be given a ticket at the end of graduation practice line up for entry onto the football field for the senior cookout • You must have a ticket
May 22 nd	Senior Awards Day <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Program will begin promptly at 10:00am • Seniors are to wear their cap & gown on this day • Seniors are allowed to leave campus after the awards • If seniors remain on campus, they must return to class and not hang out in the parking lot • If your senior is found on campus after the event, there will be consequences • Please plan accordingly • Senior Awards are normally concluded around 12 Noon

<p>June 6th</p>	<p>Graduation Practice</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plan to arrive no later than 1:15pm • We have a limited amount of time to practice so please plan to be on time • Tickets will only be given out after practice (please plan accordingly) • This process may take up to 2 hours, so we ask that you be patient • You may also want to bring the shoes you are planning to wear in order to try them out
<p>June 6th</p>	<p>Graduation Ticket Distribution</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be given 10 tickets on the day of Graduation Practice • Tickets will be distributed at the end of practice • Please do not request tickets prior to the end of practice • There is a process that we follow • Please plan accordingly
<p>June 9th</p>	<p>Graduation Ceremony</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Graduates plan to arrive no later than 10:45 • Remember if you are late, you may miss the opportunity to walk in with your class, so please be early • Please tell your guest to arrive no later than 11:30 • Please remind your guest if they are late the doors will be closed until an appropriate time to open them
