We know that many students have learning gaps due to the pandemic. To address these learning gaps, GCS will be offering the Summer Learning Program. This program is a free academic summer camp through Guilford County Schools. This summer, learning will take place at EASTERN Middle School due to scheduled maintenance at NEMS. Transportation will be provided.

Students have been selected for summer programming based on Northwest Evaluation Association Measure of Academic Progress (NWEA-MAP) results and other assessment data. If your child has been selected, you have been sent an invitation to summer learning in the mail.

Summer learning is the first step to your student's academic recovery. Our intent is for the summer learning program to be a fun experience that will help children grow academically and better prepare them for the upcoming school year.

Summer Learning Details:

- Dates: June 27 - July 21. Students are encouraged to attend the entire session, if possible.
- Instructional day: 10:15 a.m. - 3:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday.
- There will be no summer programming during the week of July 4-July 8.
- Daily activities include music, art, and physical education enrichment, as well as physical movement throughout the day.
- Small class sizes will benefit students' learning.
- Transportation will be provided upon request.
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided.
- IEP (Individual Education Plans) and 504 services will be provided.
- Students will receive small groups and individual support academically and socio-
