Testing Guidelines

- All end of year exams (EOCs/End of Course, Teacher-made and GCFEs/Guilford County Finals Exam) count as 20% of the final grade.
- Any student who does not take the exam will receive a score of 50.
 - Any student who takes the exam will not experience a devastating outcome as a result of one test grade. Students will receive the highest of:
 - A score of 60
 - Actual exam grade
 - Average of the two semesters
- Schools are required to use the retired NCFEs (North Carolina Final Exam) listed below as GCSFEs for all corresponding courses:

- GCFE's and English II will require students to bring their Chromebooks.
- Students will take the GCFE and EOC exams in-person.
- Teacher-made exams will be given remotely on 5/18-5/19.
- Students enrolled in an AP course are expected to complete an assessment during the exam window.
 - If the assessment is project based the due date is the same as the TME/Teacher-made Exam date and can be submitted digitally. Students are not required to come to campus to submit their project.
- No students will be release early on testing days.
