



Tdap/ MCV Deadline Extended!

Thanks to Executive Order 234, students in 7th and 12th grades now have until **NOV. 30** to show proof that they have received state- required vaccines.*

Students can get their immunizations by contacting their healthcare provider or by calling the health department at 336-641-3245 to schedule an appointment in High Point or Greensboro.

The district strongly encourages families to schedule appointments as soon as possible. Slots will fill up quickly. Families may contact their school's social worker if they need assistance with scheduling.

**7th graders are required to have their Tetanus diphtheria, and pertussis (Tdap) vaccination as well as their Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccination (MCV). 12th graders are required to have an MCV booster vaccination. These immunizations are required whether attending school in-person or attending a virtual school.*
