


## Apprenticeship Requirements

- → Minimum 2.8 GPA unweighted\*\*
- Math 1, Math 2, and Math 3
- Good attendance\*\*
- Attend a Company Open House with a parent or guardian

- All applications must be submitted online by January 31<sup>st</sup> at gapnc.org
  - Student completes application-opens in Nov.
  - Parent receives email to sign application
  - School career and college manager (CCM)
    receives email to provide transcript,
    attendance, and signature.
  - Don't forget to complete this!
- → DON'T WAIT TO APPLY!





- → Begins in February or March over the course of the month
- → Students and Companies learn more about each other
- → Team projects, interviews, activities, and individual work





- Start working at your chosen company and develop skills
- → Work for six weeks while attending classes at GTCC

You get paid for work and class-time, just like during your apprenticeship





- → Official event to sign apprentices
- 2022 Signing Ceremony-August 11<sup>th!</sup>
- → 56 new apprentices signed (2022); over 150 students in program currently in GAP
- → Over \$8 Million in scholarships awarded (2022)

Attend 1 or more open houses Nov.-Jan. Submit an application By Jan 31 Find out if you're selected Mid Feb. Participate in invitational March Discover companies where you want to work Start pre-apprenticeship June 12th Paid hands-on training and college classes Attend signing ceremony Aug 10th and start apprenticeship
