Exam Location

We are testing in the C Building at Ragsdale High School. Students should enter the building to take an AP exam through the Arts and Athletics entrance. No food or drink is allowed in the testing room, but breakfast and lunch from the cafeteria will be available in the Arts and Athletics commons area at 7:40AM and at 12:10PM.

Exam Times/Transportation

Please report to the Arts and Athletics Building at Ragsdale High School no later than 7:40am for a morning exam or 12:10pm for an afternoon exam. Exams will start promptly at 8:00am and 12:30PM.

The exam schedule and estimated testing times are noted in the table. **There will be some time added to the beginning and ending of exams for administrative processes.**

All students must be present at the beginning and throughout an AP exam – no one is allowed to be dismissed early from any exam.

Cell Phones, Electronics

Under no circumstance should a cell phone be in the testing room. Please leave your cell phone in your car or at home on test days. A cell phone in a student's possession will constitute a misadministration, and then all students must retake the exam. You would be required to reimburse the cost of the exam in the case of a misadministration.

Do not bring any device which has access to the internet, i.e. fitness devices, iWatches, etc or any other recording device. Test integrity and security is of utmost importance to Ragsdale High School and College Board.

What to Bring

- ✓ Several sharpened No. 2 pencils
- ✓ Pens with blue or black ink
- ✓ Up to two approved calculators with extra batteries
- ✓ A ruler if you are taking the Physics exam
- ✓ Snack for break
- ✓ Water bottle

What **NOT** to Bring

- ✓ Cell phones
- ✓ Any other electronic/communication devices
- ✓ Books, compasses, colored pencils, correction fluid, highlighters or notes
- ✓ Computers
- ✓ Watches that beep or have an alarm
- ✓ Portable listening or recording devices or photographic equipment
- ✓ Clothing with subject-related information

No Show Fee

Students are required to be present for their AP exams. A no-show fee of \$40.00 will be charged if a student fails to attend the May administration. **This fee is not being waived for the 2021-2022 school year.
