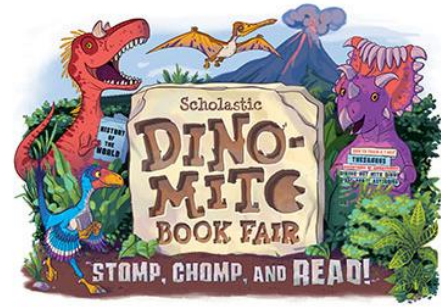


# ORES Spring Book Fair

## eWallet

Concerned your child might lose the money you sent for the book fair? Want to limit your child's purchases to just books? No cash at home? The answer to all these questions is Scholastic eWallet! eWallet gives students a secure, cash-free way to shop the fair. There is no charge to set up an eWallet. Parents simply create an account and authorize a spending limit on their credit card. Parents can even add a note to limit purchases to books only. ### Key Features

- Secure way to give kids money to buy books
- Pre-authorized amount to control spending
- Funds immediately available for use



Purchasers must create an eWallet for each student; accounts cannot be shared or transferred. A preauthorization charge will appear on the credit card in the amount selected as the spending limit. Additional funds can be added to the eWallet at any time. Parents will only be charged for what is purchased (up to the spending limit they selected). The preauthorized amount will expire after the last day of the book fair. Student eWallets can be scanned or looked up at the book fair using the student's grade, teacher, or name; eWallets do not have to be printed or presented to a cashier.
