Students will participate in end-of-year testing in Reading, Mathematics (grades 6-8), Science (grades 8), and End of Course tests in Math I, beginning on May 30, 2023.

The purpose of the standardized test is to establish a measure of your child's reading, math, and/or science skills for the 2022-2023 school year.

Your child's tests will be administered as follows:

May 30	<ul style="list-style-type: none">English 1 Final Exam
May 31	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Reading EOG
June 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">6th and 7th grade Math EOG8th grade Math I EOC8th grade Math II Final Exam
June 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">7th grade Math I EOC8th grade Science EOC
June 5 - 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Make-up Testing

Following the EOG Test administration, each family will receive an Individual Student Report (ISR) with each child's score. This report will display your child's reading, math, and/or science scores compared to other students in Guilford County and North Carolina.

Students should go to bed early, have a good breakfast and get to school on time each day for testing. We encourage students to arrive at 8am. Please remind students to:

- attempt each question or prompt on the test;
- refrain from causing distractions for other students during testing;
- not bring extra scratch paper, dictionaries, reference books, textbooks, cameras, thumb drives, smartpens, smartwatches, music, thesauruses, cell phones, other electronic device;
- bring a novel or other non-textbook, such as a magazine, to read after they complete the test administration.
