



2019-20 SWMS STUDENT DRESS CODE

All students are expected to dress in a manner that promotes safety and does not distract from the learning environment; specifically:

Clothing, headgear, and jewelry- Must never contain violent, offensive, or sexually suggestive phrases or images. These include, but are not limited to: gang related symbols, alcohol, tobacco, or drug related slogans or advertisements.

Shirts - Must have sleeves, must cover cleavage and arm pits, must not be see-through, and must be long enough to cover the entire midriff. Shirts will be worn such that undergarments will not be revealed.

Pants/Shorts/Skirts - Must be worn at the waist (no sagging), must be longer than the length of extended fingertips while the skirt or shorts are worn at the natural waistline, must be worn so that undergarments are not visible, must have no words or slogans written across the back.

“Stretch pants” (i.e., leggings, jeggings, yoga pants, etc.) may be worn *only* with tops that extend the length of the thumb. Pants or shorts with holes or slits must have a permanent layer underneath. Pajama pants are not allowed at any time.

Hats/Hoods/Head Cover – Hats, hoods, and do-rags must be removed and secured when entering the building. Classic paisley print bandana apparel is not permitted in any color.

Shoes - Shoes must be worn at all times. Any sandal or flip-flop type of shoe must have a secure back strap. Bedroom shoes are not permitted.

Accessories– Accessories that contain technology may need to be removed by request of teacher. Smartwatches may not be visible during any testing situation. Cell phones are not to be seen at any time, and any personal device which has the capability of producing sound or music is to remain at home.
