**Career and Technical Education (CTE) Update**

- Tresha Layne provided a high level update on the district's CTE vision. A work session on CTE, including the 5-year plan being developed at the Superintendent's direction following the recommendation of the Blue Ribbon Task Force and the Transition Team, is being planned for the full Board of Education this fall.
  - Darlene Garrett asked staff to provide the percentage of GCS students enrolled in CTE.
  - Tresha Layne offered to provide the Committee two reports:
    - Southern Regional Education Board (SREB) Credentials for All: An Imperative for SREB States Executive Summary
    - Career Pathways: Five Ways to Connect College and Career
- The Committee agreed they would like to receive them.

**GCS 2019 Legislative Agenda Priorities**

- The Committee does not anticipate a lot of revisions to the GCS Legislative Agenda for 2019. They will continue reviewing the 2018 legislative agenda and then discuss again at the September Committee meeting.
- The Committee asked staff to provide the Greensboro Chamber of Commerce with GCS' CTE related request for the Chamber's 2019 State Legislative Agenda. Winston McGregor shared that the deadline has been extended about a month (approximately September 24).

**North Carolina School Boards Action Center (NCSBAC)**

- The Committee decided not to contribute to the NCSBAC for 2018-19.
