

Dear Parents,

Here are some things to look over as your child completes work in Canvas.

Have your student check their “Inbox” daily for any messages.

Assignments: Make sure your child is logging in everyday and completing those daily assignments. As of now, the week’s assignments must be turned in by Sunday evening. As students go through a Nearpod lesson, please make sure they are answering all the questions asked. If a slide says to write or draw, please do one or the other. Make sure they are submitting their work. (Sometimes, a student may just click through the slides and submit.) We can see daily what answers they have submitted.

Grades: One way for you check their progress is to click on the grades button. When looking at their grades, some things to consider:

A check mark = assignment graded and completed.

An X = not submitted or incomplete.

Comments on assignments: As I grade the assignments, I put in comments such as “Completed,” “Nice work” or even an emoji. Sometimes I will put a comment that asks a student to redo the assignment because it may not have been completed or they left something out.

You can see comments on the home page (where the monthly tabs are located) to the right side of the page under the Things to Do list. There should be a header that says “Recent Feedback”. (Do this 1st; below is another way)

You can also see comments when you click on the Grades button, then click on the check mark or X on the assignment. Once you click on the check mark or X, you will see a little box with an arrow. Click on the arrow and the comment should pop up on the right side of the page.

I hope this helps with navigating in Canvas and allowing you to see your Gator’s progress. Please remind them to be thoughtful about what they post, as it can be seen by everyone.
