- **Annual Meeting:** The High Point Central High School Title I Annual Meeting will be held on September 13, 2022.
- **Flexible Meetings:** High Point Central High School will offer meetings held in the mornings and afternoons to accommodate our parents' schedules. Meeting information will be posted to our website.
- **Involve parents in the development of PFE plan and the Title I program:** Parents are welcome to provide input and feedback as plans and programs are developed throughout the school year at the School Leadership Team Meetings and by completing surveys throughout the school year. Meeting dates are posted on our website.
- **Provide information to parents:** Our school will hold a walk the schedule night each semester; publish a weekly newsletter with events and information, send ConnectEd messages weekly with updates; and provide information on our website.
