- **Introductions of Officers** – Sara St. Clair and Shelly Beck were both in attendance in the meeting. Ms. Lowe and Ms. Champion were not in attendance for this meeting. - **Read and approve minutes from last meeting 1/6/22** – Sara St. Clair read the minutes from last meeting on 1-6-22, Ms. Daniels approved the meeting minutes through a motion and Mrs. Kreuser seconded the motion to approve the minutes.
- **Principal's Report** – Mrs. Cooper talked about the car line and transportation concerns and congratulated parents for getting to school earlier and continuing to make right turns in the afternoon to pick their students up from school. She asked that parents not go through the semi-circle driveway until your student is actually tardy (past 7:25 AM) in order to keep everyone safe.
Mrs. Cooper announced the teacher of the Year for this school year is Nate Reeser, our PE Teacher. Congrats to Mr. Reeser. The GoFar Club has started again and is moving along. The Chorus Club has started and will sing the National Anthem on April 8, 2022 and information will be coming out about how to get tickets for that in a section reserved for Millis Road. Volunteers are starting to sign up to work with students and are being paired with students. Coming very soon....Mondays through Thursdays students will be able to have lunch with their parents outside if it is a nice day and Fridays will be organized for classes to eat in the cafeteria and parents can sign up for that through their child's teacher as soon as that is ready to start. There is a Lunch and Learn about SEL (Social Emotional Strategies) happening tomorrow, 3-11-22, 11:45 – 12:15 virtually and all are welcome to attend. Mrs. Cooper mentioned that bookshelves have been ordered for the Media Center as well other classroom supplies through the school fundraiser that started in the fall. She also thanked the PTA for the Taco Bar for the staff and noted that it was loved by all.
- **President's and/or Vice President's Report**
 - **World's Finest Chocolate Fundraiser update** - We raised approximately \$5000 but not all money has been collected yet and there are still a few boxes being distributed and sold. Overall, the fundraiser was a huge success.
 - **Chic-fil-a Spirit Night update (Katie Bermudez)** –Freddy's Spirit Night raised \$512 and Chic-Fil-A raised \$585.34. March 22, 2022 is the next Spirit Night and we get a 10%

commission on all sales for the entire day but you have to mention Millis Road in order for us to get the profit. We will have another Chic-Fil-A Night in the Spring.

- Freddy's Spirit Night update (Katie Bermudez) – Next time we will receive only 15% instead of 30%.
- Spiritwear update– Our last Spirit Wear sale earned us \$123 but the Sticker Man company rounded up the amount to \$200. Thanks to Sticker Man!
- Monthly Thank you gifts – Thanks to everyone who has signed up and provided monthly treats for the staff. The staff has been extremely appreciative and wanted to say a big thanks to the PTA. All sign up slots have been filled for this school year but keep in mind there will be spots open for next school year.
- Treasurer's Report – Money amounts have already been mentioned earlier in this meeting under different agenda topics
- New Business
 - Spirit night will be March 22nd at Bad Daddy's Burger Bar from 11:30am to 9:30pm
 - Spring Cleanup – April 9, 2022 or April 30, 2022 was suggested but April 9, 2022 was chosen as the official date and the time is 9-12 with the possibility of extending it to additional afternoon hours.
 - Teacher Appreciation May 2-6th - This is quickly approaching and the PTA is taking ideas for a them for this year to honor and thank our teachers.
 - Book Fair will be May 13-19th. – This is the Buy One, get One Free Book Fair. Mrs. Massengale does not make money for the school library at all. We will be asking for volunteers to work at the Book Fair. More info to come.
 - Volunteering on Campus – Everyone has to fill out a Volunteer Form with GCs in order to come in and work with the students. Mrs. Cooper provided the link to that in the chat for people to complete in order to be able to volunteer on campus. Volunteers will be needed for Field Day in the spring and information will be coming out soon on how to sign up for that.
