

4-YEAR COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR APPLYING

- Apply to minimum 3-5 schools
- Have at least 1 safety school, 2 target schools, and 1 reach school
- Apply early! (Higher chance of getting accepted, School-specific scholarships, Honors College)
- Ask for recommendations early
- ▶ Do not wait until the last minute to submit applications

KEEP IN MÍND

- Most schools require at LEAST a 2.5 GPA just to apply
- However, you have to look at their average GPA for acceptance, not the minimum
- There are certain schools that accept students with GPAs 2.5-2.0
 - Talk to Mr.Moore to learn about these schools
- Community colleges highly recommended if GPA is
 2.5 or lower
- Student athletes have to register with NCAA Eligibility Center and speak to coach (talk to Mr.Moore)

RDS (NORTH CAROLINA RESIDENCY)

Why Do I Need to Do the RDS?
The RDS verifies that you are a North
Carolina resident.

North Carolina Resident = in state-tuition

in-state tuition = Saving \$\$\$\$\$

See/Talk to me ASAP if:

- You live with people that are not your legal guardians
- You or your parents do not have a social security numbers
- You are in unstable living/housing conditions

Materials Needed

- Social Security Number (parent/guardian and student)
- If you do not have a social security number, an alien registration number,
 USCIS number, or tax identification number (ITIN) can be used*
- Birthday (parent/guardian and student)
- Driver's License Number or State ID Number (parent/guardian only)
- Method (Online vs. Mail) and year of when parent/guardian last filed NC Taxes (if applicable)

FAFSA (FINANCIAL AID)

The system the US Department of Education uses to determine how much money your parents make, and therefore how much financial aid you can get.

Create FSA ID before FAFSA opens!

Takes 1-3 days to be verified

Materials Needed

- Social Security number or alien registration number (student and parent/guardian)
- Birthday (student and parent/guardian)
- Date of marriage, divorce, or separation (if applicable)
- 2022 income tax refunds (if filed), W-2, and any other documents that may report income or money earned (student and parent/guardian)
- If applicable: bank and investment information and records of untaxed income
- FSA ID to electronically sign (student and parent/guardian)






